**ELECTRICAL CODE PREP CLASS FOR BECOMING A  
CERTIFIED ELECTRICAL SAFETY INSPECTOR**

The JATC is considering scheduling a Code Class that would help prepare an individual in taking the State of Ohio exam for becoming a certified electrical safety inspector (CESI).

The class would consist of in depth study of Chapters 1 – 4; these are the chapters that are most frequently used by inspectors in the field, as well as pertinent sections of the remaining chapters. The class will also outline the requirements for, and the process of applying to take the exam.

The class would be on five (5) consecutive Thursday nights, 6:00 to 9:30.  
John Humphrey will be the Instructor.

The cost of this class would be \$150.00, which includes a copy of the  
2008 National Electrical Code Handbook with tabs.

Payment would be required prior to the first night of class.

## **IBEW Constitution - Article XXI - Members in Arrears - Page 63**

Sec. 3. Any member indebted to his L.U. for three months' dues, or having any past due indebtedness to the I.B.E.W. for dues or assessments, shall stand suspended, and the L.U. may refuse to accept dues from any member who is indebted to it. Such member cannot be reinstated until all indebtedness has been paid, unless waived by the L.U. However, dues cannot be waived.

Sec. 4. Any member indebted to his L.U. for six (6) months' full dues shall be dropped from membership by the F.S. and cannot become a member in good standing again in the I.B.E.W. except by joining as a new member.

Sec. 5. Members who are suspended forfeit all rights and previous standing in the I.B.E.W., including any pension or death benefits payable from the Pension Benefit Fund.
